

FAQ – answers to frequently asked questions about the Informatica Feminale – 27th International Summer University for Women in Computing at Bremen University, Germany:

- online as *meantime* courses in 2024 year-round and
- as *summer school* on place in Bremen from 14 to 29 August 2024.

Who can participate?

Every interested woman (regardless of background), provided that she meets the predefined requirements of each individual course. We welcome female participants from Germany as well as from abroad! Teaching languages are German and English.

How much is the participation fee?

Online-Program: free of charge for all.

OnPlace-Program: Students and unemployed are charged a one-time fee of 40 Euro for a participation of two weeks – regardless for which of the two summer universities *Ingenieurinnen-Sommeruni* or *Informatica Feminale*. The participation fee can be waived for those who support the conference office for approximately 4 hours. We offer travel scholarships.

Employed women pay a fee of 40 Euro a day.

What certificates can I acquire?

The University of Bremen issues confirmations of participation for attending particular courses. As most of the courses concerning duration and requirements correspond to regular semester courses, certificates and Credit Points can be achieved. Participants will have to apply for the recognition of their achievements at their home college themselves. The courses that are accredited by the University of Bremen are marked in the program.

Is childcare provided?

During the entire summer university on campus, childcare is provided for free. Children need to be previously registered with their ages and their time schedules concerning childcare.

Where do I find lodging and meals?

Participants will have to organise their lodging and meals themselves. References to affordable accommodation can be found on the website. During the entire summer university a cafeteria will be at your disposal for free; hot meals can be purchased from an extensive assortment of several dining halls at the campus of the University of Bremen.
